INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON MANAGEMENT'S ASSERTION

Honorable Town Council
Town of Woodside, California

We have examined management of the Town of Woodside's assertion, included in the accompanying Management's Report on Compliance with the *Agreement for Distribution of San Mateo County Measure W Funds for Local Transportation Purposes in Accordance with the San Mateo County Congestion Relief Plan (the Agreement)* between the Town of Woodside and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority dated September 24, 2019, that the Town complied with the requirements of the Agreement during the year ended June 30, 2022. Management is responsible for that assertion. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on management's assertion about the City's compliance based upon our examination.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with the attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Those standards require that we plan and perform the examination to obtain reasonable assurance about whether management's assertion that the Town complied with the requirements of the Agreement is fairly stated, in all material respects. An examination involves performing procedures to obtain evidence about management's assertion. The nature, timing and extent of procedures selected depend on our judgment, including an assessment of the risks of material misstatement of management's assertion, whether due to fraud or error. We believe that the evidence we obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

We are required to be independent and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to the engagement.

In our opinion, management's assertion that the Town complied with the requirements of the Agreement for the year ended June 30, 2022 is fairly stated, in all material respects.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of management, the Town Council and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than those specified parties; however, this restriction is not intended to limit the distribution of this report, which is a matter of public record.

Management's Report on Compliance with the *Agreement for Distribution of San Mateo County Measure W Funds for Local Transportation Purposes in accordance with the San Mateo County Congestion Relief Plan*

The Town of Woodside is responsible for complying with the *Agreement for Distribution of San Mateo County Measure W Funds for Local Transportation Purposes in Accordance with the San Mateo County Congestion Relief Plan* (the Agreement) between the Town and the San Mateo County Transportation Authority entered into on September 24, 2020. The Agreement states that in return for receiving an annual allocation of a specified portion of the retail transactions and use tax approved by *Measure W – San Mateo County Transportation Expenditure Plan* (the Measure), the Town agrees that funds shall not be used to replace funds previously provided for public transportation investments, and that Town will limit the use of funds provided pursuant to this Agreement to invest in major arterial and local roadway improvements in key congested areas throughout the County, focusing on improving safety, reducing congestion, and supporting all modes of travel on the County's roadway system.
