The intent of this fire protection plan is to outline and manage ways to minimize and mitigate potential loss from wildfire exposure.</p> <p><u>The following must be included:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A site fire protection plan. 2. Methods and timetables for controlling, changing, or modifying areas of the property. 3. A fire protection maintenance plan for the proposed fuel reduction measures. 			
<p>Elements of the fire protection plan shall include the removal of slash, snags, other ground fuels, dead trees, annual grass mowing, as well as thinning of live trees and bushes to reduce dead wood and vegetation continuity. Special consideration should be given to defensible space within 30'-100' zone of any structure, and 30' inside the perimeter of the property line. A fire protection plan template is available at www.woodsidefire.org.</p>
