* If material from excavations will not be exported from site and if more than 100 cubic yards in volume of three feet in depth of materials is to be spread on site, a **Site Development Permit** is required (per section 151.20 of the Woodside Site Development Ordinance). Plans shall indicate where and at what depth such material will be placed.

This application is intended for the review of a private wastewater disposal system to be permitted by the County of San Mateo. This application is being reviewed based on the dimensions and information provided on the plans submitted with this application. This application will not remain valid if such plans are not an accurate representation of the proposed work.

Please note: Any waste water disposal system must be in compliance with sections 51.030 through 51.032 of the Town of Woodside Municipal Code. Please submit **three** copies of a site plan that accurately shows the locations of existing/proposed septic tank (s) and drain field lines in relation to the following.

- **Percolation test pits.** At least **three** pits must be in the area of the proposed primary drain field and at least **three** pits must be in the area of the 100% expansion area.
 - **Buildings and property lines.** Septic tanks must be at least **five feet** from any dwelling and **ten feet** from any property line. Drain field and expansion area lines must be at least **ten feet** from any dwelling or property line.
 - **Trees.** If drain field lines are proposed within the drip line of any tree >30 inches in circumference, measured four feet from the ground, Town staff will normally require a site inspection be made prior to permit issuance or submittal of an arborist report addressing potential impacts.
 - **Topography of the site.** Septic tanks and drain field are not allowed on slopes which exceed **35%** or within **50 feet** of any ditch (*note that piping of ditches does not eliminate the ditch setback requirement*), cut-bank or slope which exceeds **50%**. An Engineering Geology investigation report is required for all septic drain fields to be located on slopes between **20% and 35%** or on a landslide mapped on the Towns' Geologic Map. The report must address slope stability and day lighting of effluent.
 - **Streams.** Septic tanks and drain field lines are not allowed within **50 feet** of the top of a stream bank.
 - **Swimming Pools.** Septic tanks and drain field lines are not allowed within **25 feet** of a swimming pool.
 - **Wells.** Septic tanks and drain field lines are not allowed within **100 feet** of any well.
 - **Domestic water supply reservoir.** Drain field lines are not allowed within **200 feet** of any such reservoir.
- *Note: piping of ditches does not eliminate the ditch setback requirement***

Please note that Native American burial sites have been discovered in the past on certain properties in Woodside. California State Law requires that excavations and/ or site disturbance be immediately terminated upon the discovery or recognition of any human remains or artifacts. Should such items be discovered during construction, please cease all site work and immediately contact the Town of Woodside.
