GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR USE OF BARKLEY FIELDS AND PARK

Revised January 20, 2020

PLEASE NOTE: Failure to comply with these Town policies and procedures may result in suspension of privilege of Barkley Fields and Park use. References to "Park" pertain to Barkley Fields and Park, including the adjacent parking lot. Rules and regulations for use of Barkley Fields and Park by sports leagues are contained in the Application for Use of Barkley Fields available on the Town's website.

- 1. Hours:** The Park is open from sunrise to one-half hour after sunset and shall be vacated upon closure. No person shall enter, use, cross, or remain in the Park during the hours the Park is closed.
- 2. Parking:** Park users must park in the designated areas, respect "NO PARKING" signs, and refrain from blocking access to trails, gates, and driveways.
- 3. Litter:** Litter, debris, garbage and any other items resulting from the use of the Park shall be placed in the appropriate containers.
- 4. Fire:** No barbeque grills and/or fires of any kind are permitted in the Park.
- 5. Smoking:** Smoking is not permitted in the Park.
- 6. Alcohol:** Possession or consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the Park.
- 7. Recreational Drugs:** Possession or consumption of recreational drugs of any kind is not permitted in the Park.
- 8. Weapons:** No weapons are allowed in the Park, except those carried by duly sworn law enforcement personnel.
- 9. Amplified Sound:** No amplified sound is permitted in the Park.
- 10. Field Closure:** Park users shall immediately cease use of the field turf if weather or playing conditions do not permit safe use, or if damage to the field will result.
- 11. Park Property:** Removal of turf, soil, grass, tree, shrub, or portion thereof; or tampering with any component of the field irrigation system, restroom facility, or park equipment is prohibited.
- 12. Dogs:** Dogs shall remain leashed and under the control of the owner or competent person. Dog owners or possessors shall prevent their dogs from causing lawful injury or harassment to other Park users. Dogs are allowed only on designated paths in the Park. Dog training is prohibited in the Park.
- 13. Disorderly Conduct:** Causing, creating, encouraging, or threatening to cause any disturbance which may reasonably result in injury or property damage, or disturb the peace, comfort and security of Park patrons is prohibited.

14. Field Reservations: The Town shall only accept and approve field usage applications from official, organized youth leagues that serve the residents of the Town of Woodside. *No other reservations shall be permitted.* Field users without field usage applications may use the field on a first come, first served basis during those times when the field has not been reserved and when weather and field conditions permit. The Park shall not be used for tournament play, except that single tournament games may be scheduled in which an official youth league that serves the residents of the Town of Woodside is a participant and that meets all Town operating policies, regulations, and laws.

15. Private or Commercial Activities: Private or commercial activities, including, but not limited to, weddings, concerts, reunions, private sports lessons, dog training and private club activities are not permitted.
